Our domestic sales and distribution partners often contact us with several interesting projects, the latest was renewing the ageing hot water system at Abingdon Rugby Football Club in Oxfordshire. This installation which involved removing old storage cylinders and replacing them with three of our 300 SAHP.

This commercial installation will see the club relying on the SAHPs to provide hot water to the showers and changing room as well as the club bar area.

The inadequate existing hot water system relied on ageing vented cylinders directly heated using costly-to-run inefficient immersion heaters.

Three SAHP 300Ls produce up to 1,200 litres of 40°C mixed water to the showers, wash hand basins and kitchen sink of the clubhouse, whilst reducing the running costs, CO<sup>2</sup> emissions and improving the EPC of the sports pavilion.
